

PSALM 86

Stretch out Your ear, O Lord I implore; attend to me now, for I'm humble and poor.

- 2 Hedge round my soul, for Your good deeds I do; my God save Your servant, who trusts now in You.
- 3 Show me Your mercy, and favor I pray; O Lord I call to You; all of the day.
- 4 Brighten the soul, of the servant You love; O Lord lift up, my soul high above.
- 5 Lord You are gracious, forgiving to me; abundant in mercy, to all who seek Thee.
- 6 Listen O Lord, when I plead to You there; prick up Your ears, as I call in my prayer.
- 7 In the day of my anguish, I'll call on Your name; for Your eye's upon me, You're ever the same.
- 8 Among all their gods, there is none Lord as You; none ever accomplish, the great things You do.
- 9 All nations You've made, will worship Your face; Lord they shall honor, Your name all their days.
- 10 For You are the greatest, 'tis You we applaud; wonderfully working, You only are God.
- 11 Show me the way Lord, in Your truth to trod; join my heart in respect, for Your name my God.
- 12 I'll praise thee O Lord God, with my heart adore; and magnify Your name, now and evermore.
- 13 Great is Your mercy, that over me sits; snatching my soul, from the lowermost pit.
- 14 Presumptuous men rise, O God evil swarms; ungodly know not Thee; and seek my soul's harm.
- 15 But You Lord Almighty, have mercy and grace; true patience and kindness, abound in Your ways.
- 16 Your face and Your favor, give might to Your slave; the son of Your handmaid, You freely do save.
- 17 Give me a good sign, that my foes may see; shame them O Lord, for Your help comforts me.
