- 4 Let all who truly fear the Lord, now say His mercy's true; His kindness to the end of time, His favor ever new.
- 5 I called upon the Lord, in my distress and troubled times; the Lord gave heed and brought me to, a place so broad and wide.
- 6 The Lord is with me so I'll never, fear or be afraid; how could Adam's sons bring harm, (when in His arms I'm laid)?
- 7 The Lord surrounds and succors me, in everything I do; and I will see my enemies, get all that they are due.
- 8 It's best to flee unto the Lord, and put your trust in Him; than hoping in all those around, relying on mere men.
- 9 It's best to flee unto the Lord, and trust in His reward; than hoping in a prince's power, or in a "noble's" word.
- 10 Every nation that surrounds me, all their troops that came; I will stop victoriously, now in the Lord's great name.
- 11 They compassed me yea at my borders, victory to claim; but I will stop them valiantly, now in the Lord's great name.
- 12 Revolved around me thick as bees, but as dried thorns soon burn; in Thy mighty name O Lord, I'll cut them down in turn.
- 13 They pushed and pushed against me, hoping that I'd fall; but the Lord was my mainstay, and saw me through it all.
- 14 The Lord is my true power, and the song that's in my heart; becoming my salvation, healing me in every part.
- 15 They call and shout "Messiah," in the tents of God's just men; the Lord's right hand makes wealth unto, all those who honor Him.
- 16 The Lord's right hand is lifted up, (and raised to meet our need); the Lord's right hand does valiantly, (unto all of our seed).
- 17 I will not die but live and with, my soul fully declare; enumerating all the deeds, of the Lord's tender care.
- 18 The Lord instructs me where I need it, so that He may save; never lets the adversary, put me in the grave.
- 19 Open wide the doors so all, the just may enter in; I will come and lift my hands, unto the Lord again.
